

## **ADULT AND SENIOR CANINE WELLNESS AND VACCINE SCHEDULE**

FROM 1 YEAR TO 5-7 YEARS OLD (Depending on Breed Longevity)

### THE FOLLOWING IS DUE YEARLY

- Yearly physical exam
- Weight Check – discuss proper nutrition and feeding schedules
- Canine Distemper Vaccine (DA2LPP)
- Lyme Vaccine
- Rabies Vaccine  
*(Rabies vaccines given according to schedule will turn into a rabies vaccine every 3 years)*
- 4DX Test – blood test to check for heartworm, Lyme disease, and other tick borne diseases
- Blood Panel – checks blood counts and organ function  
*(Your veterinarian will let you know if blood work is warranted)*
- Receive 12 months of Sentinel heartworm/intestinal parasite/flea prevention
- Bordetella Vaccine *(kennel cough) should be given if your dog will be boarded, attend training classes, or going to the groomer. This can be given any time and feel free to discuss it with your veterinarian.*
- Receive 12 months of flea/tick prevention

### FROM 6 YEARS OLD TO SENIORS

- Yearly physical exam
- Weight Check – discuss senior diets and feeding amounts
- Distemper Vaccine (DA2LPP) – every 3 years
- Leptospirosis Vaccine – every year (part of the distemper vaccine that does not provide immunity unless given every year).
- Lyme Vaccine – yearly
- Rabies Vaccine – every 3 years
- 4DX Test – blood test to check for heartworm, Lyme disease, and other tick borne diseases, done yearly
- Blood Panel – checks blood counts and organ function, done yearly
- Receive 12 months of Sentinel heartworm/intestinal parasite/flea prevention
- Bordetella Vaccine *(kennel cough) should be given if your dog will be boarded, attend training classes, or going to the groomer. This can be given any time and feel free to discuss it with your veterinarian. Given yearly unless otherwise specified by boarding/daycare facility.*
- Receive 12 months of flea/tick prevention
